Welcome Visitors: We welcome you in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ! Our prayer is that you will rejoice with us today in our good and mighty God through the good news of the risen Savior. It is our chief calling as a church to worship Him together. If you do not trust in Jesus for life and salvation, we pray that God will work in your heart to repent and turn to him today (Romans 3:23-24). If you wish to learn more about our church, any pastor or elder is happy to speak with you.

Prayer Focus: What does it mean to have eternal life? Jesus answers that question in today's sermon text. In John 17:3, Jesus says that "this is eternal life, that they know you and Jesus Christ whom you have sent." Jesus is not talking about the knowledge that a judge has of a convict but the knowledge that a man has of a friend (Exodus 33:11, John 15:15). Do you know God in this way? If you do, praise the Lord! Pray to go "further up and further in" such knowledge. If you do not know God, pray for the Holy Spirit to graciously apply the finished work of Christ's reconciliation to your heart so that you would no longer be God's enemy but God's friend.
